Personal Health and Safety

- When riding in Mears vehicle please do not lean forward toward the driver or over the seat.
- > Please, no hand shaking and maintain as little contact as possible.
- > Hand sanitizer, with at least 60% alcohol, will be available to all drivers and guests (pending product availability).
- > Per CDC regulations, all guests are required to wear masks in vehicles.
- Mask wearing is mandatory for all Mears' fleet drivers.
 - Florida's Orange County Executive Order requires mandatory face coverings by all, including guests.
 - > Check all City, County, State etc. local requirements prior to travelling.
- All motor coach and shuttle van drivers will have their temperature taken and screened, daily.
- All taxi and luxury contractors will be screened, to include temperature checks.

Vehicle out or come in if they are not feeling well and to follow CDC guidelines.

- Luxury/Taxi Vehicles
 - > Please, no guests in the front passenger seat of any vehicle type.
 - > 3 guests max in sedan cab.
 - Or guest/client choice.
 - > 5 guests max in SUV cab. (LUXURY ONLY)
 - > Or guest/client choice.
 - > 7 guests max in van cab.
 - Or guest/client choice.
- Motor Coaches & Shuttle Vans
 - First guest(s) in should go to back of the coach and load from the rear forward.
 - No guests to sit in first row or the front passenger seat.
 - Groups travelling together.
 - Occupancy decided by group.
 - Mixed travelers
 - Mears will work with group/client to establish parameters and to be defined by group/client.
 - > Mears will continuously review current CDC & local government information.
